The Annual International Student House (ISH-DC) Global Leadership Awards will be held on **Thursday**, **October 22**, **2015** at ISH's historic facilities located at 1825 R Street, NW. Founded in 1936, ISH offers an unparalleled residential experience to a diverse community of graduate students, academics and post-graduate interns. Over 12,000 scholars representing over 140 countries, including the United States, have passed through the doors of ISH since our founding. Residents are offered special activities throughout the year that instill a spirit of cooperation while building a solid understanding of US culture, government and business. It is in this spirit that ISH-DC encourages our Resident Scholars to participate in outreach and volunteer activities. Through our in-depth programs and focus on cross-cultural dialogue, ISH-DC strives to be a model international community and represents "soft diplomacy" at its best.

This year, ISH-DC will honor Lt. General Brent Scowcroft, with our Global Leadership Award for his lifelong commitment to and his achievements in promoting intercultural dialogue. During his distinguished career, General Scowcroft served as the National Security Advisor to both Presidents Gerald Ford and George H.W. Bush, the only individual in U.S. history appointed to the position under two different Presidents. Dr. Anne-Marie Slaughter will receive the Global Educator Award for her commitment to education and international understanding. In addition to being the first woman to hold the position of Director of Policy Planning for the United States Department of State, Dr. Slaughter served as the Dean of Princeton's Woodrow Wilson School of Public and



International Affairs. ISH-DC will also honor **Ambassador Geir H. Haarde of Iceland** with our Distinguished Alumni Award for his commitment to global citizenship and fostering intercultural relations. Ambassador Haarde was a resident of the House in 1973 and 1974.

This annual event is regularly attended by Members of Congress, US Government officials, and members of Washington, DC's corporate, philanthropic, and embassy communities

This year's Diplomatic Chairs, Ambassador and Mrs. Kenichiro Sasae of Japan, will host a special ISH Tribute dinner at their beautiful Embassy Residence for our honorees and major sponsors on Thursday, September 17. The dinner celebrates the strong global partnership that the United States and Japan have developed during the past 70 years and the common values and principles that have made this bilateral relationship so enduring. ISH-DC has played an exceptional role in supporting this partnership -- since our founding, ISH-DC has welcomed more than 1,200 Japanese resident scholars to our House.
