The 2018 International Student House (ISH-DC) Global Leadership Award will be presented to U. S. Senator Patrick J. Leahy (D-VT) and U.S. Senator Susan Collins (R-ME) at a dinner which will be held in November

2018, date to be confirmed, at our historic building in the Dupont neighborhood. Senator Leahy is the Vice Chair of the Committee on Appropriations and the senior-most member of the Judiciary Committee and of the Agriculture Committee. Senator Collins serves on the Intelligence Committee and the Committee on Health, Education, Labor and Pensions. She is Chair of the Senate Select Committee on Aging and the Transportation, Housing, and Urban Development Appropriations Subcommittee. ISH-DC is pleased to recognize these senior members of the US Senate for their distinguished service to our country and work on behalf of international understanding and education.

This annual Awards Dinner is regularly attended by foreign Ambassadors and embassy representatives, Members of Congress, US Government officials, representatives of the international business community, and Washingtonians committed to international education.

The Diplomatic Chair, **Ambassador Gérard Araud of France** will host a special Tribute Dinner at his Embassy Residence for our major sponsors and special guests in early 2019. 


