Metro

The Washington Metro offers BWI Express Metro bus service between BWI and the Greenbelt Metro station.

The BWI Express/B30 service runs every 40 minutes, 7 days a week. There are two WMATA Bus Stops. One is located on the lower level of the International Pier and the other stop is located on the lower level of Concourse A/B. The B30 will pick you up outside at the bus shelter. Follow the signs that say "Public Transit".

You will need to purchase a metro card. <u>Click here for an instructional video.</u>

If you have international data coverage, enter 1825 R Street NW, Washington, DC into a map application and follow the directions.

Metro Cont.

If you will not have access to a cell phone use these step by step instructions:

- From the Greenbelt Metro Station take Green Line (direction of Branch Avenue)
- Get off at Fort Totten Metro Station
- Transfer to the Red Line (Direction Shady Grove) to the Dupont Circle
- Get off at Dupont Circle (use the Q Street North Exit)
- Cross over Connecticut Avenue to 19th Street (about 1 block)
- Turn left onto 19th Street towards R Street
- Turn right onto R Street
- Proceed to 1825 R Street (ISH-DC) on the lefthand side of the street.

Super Shuttle

Super Shuttle stops are clearly identified on the Ground Transportation Level roadway.

Alternately you can call 1-800- 258-3826 to check exact fares from BWI. Please note that fares may vary depending on the amount of luggage you have.

The trip takes about an hour and this will drop you off directly at ISH-DC (1825 R Street NW).

Shuttles operate on an on-demand basis. This means if you are the first person to request the service, you will wait until the van has enough passengers for the company to start a trip.

Amtrak

Amtrak trains provides free shuttle service from the airport terminal to the BWI Rail Station. For ticket prices go to: www.amtrak.com

MARC Trains

Use the free Amtrak shuttle from the airport terminal to the BWI Rail Station.

MARC is the Maryland commuter train line. They are significantly cheaper than Amtrak trains, but run on a limited schedule.

Taxi/Uber/Lyft

Approximate one-way fares to Washington, DC, range from \$60-80 for the one-hour trip.

The BWI taxi stand is located just outside of the baggage claim area of the Lower Level of the BWI Airport Terminal.
